

## U.P. Awas Evam Vikas Parishad Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q1. What are the minimum eligibility criteria?

Ans. Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as below:

**Assistant Engineer (Civil/Electrical/Mechanical)** – Knowledge of Hindi Language and graduate (B.tech/B.E. from Civil/Electrical/Mechanical) from any government recognized institution/university.

Q2. Can data once entered be edited?

Ans. Data entered can be edited before submitting the online form. Cannot be edited after clicking "submit."

Q3. Is NOC from the existing government job required at the time of joining(if selected in CBT)/Filling Form?

Ans. Yes, the NOC from the existing government job is required at the time of joining (if selected in CBT) and not at the time of filling the form.

Q4. Are candidates allowed to apply in case of awaited results?

Ans. Candidates, who have essential qualification required at the time of last date of submission of the application form, are eligible to fill the form.

Q5. Are correspondence or distance learning courses acceptable?

Ans. No, correspondence or distance learning courses are not acceptable.

Q6. Can candidates holding degree(evening shift) apply or not.

Ans. Yes, candidates holding degree(evening shift) can apply if it's a regular degree course.

Q7. Is it compulsory for the applicant to be passed out from Government recognized university?

Ans. Yes, it is compulsory for the applicant to be passed out from a recognized Government university.

Q8. What is the website's name and where can the link be found?

Ans. The name of Parishad's website is [www.upavp . com](http://www.upavp.com), from where the link can be found out.

Q9. What is the form submission Fee?

Ans. For General/OBC Candidates – Rs 1000/ + Bank Charges & Service tax on bank charges SC/ST candidates– Rs 500/ + Bank Charges & Service tax on bank charges For both online and offline payment

Q10. What will be the pattern of question paper (Subjective/Objective)?

Ans. The paper will be Objective type in nature where in Aptitude section will carry 25 Questions and Technical Section will carry 75 Questions.

Q11. What are the mandatory fields to be filled in the e-form?

Ans. All fields are mandatory.

Q12. What is the salary of Assistant Engineer (CIVIL/ELECTRICAL/MECHANICAL)?

Ans. Payscale of Assistant Engineer(Civil/Electrical/Mechanical) is PB-3 Rs. 15,600 - 39,100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 5,400/-

Q13. What is the Age Relaxation for physically handicapped persons/Non UP/Completed studies from other state, but is from UP.?

Ans. For Physically Handicapped candidates the age relaxation is of 15 years i.e. max age limit is 55 years if post is identified for Physically Handicapped Candidate. In present recruitment for the post of Assistant Engineer no post is identified for Physically Handicapped Candidates. Hence, no relaxation for age limit shall be considered.

Q14. What is the last date of depositing the registration fees?

Ans. The last day for submitting the Online application form is **07-11-2016** and last day for submitting the offline payment through e-Challan is **08-11-2016**.

Q15. What are the examination dates?

Ans. The tentative date for examination is **30<sup>th</sup> November 2016**.

Q16. Which are the cities in which examination will be conducted?

Ans. Examination will be conducted in 14 cities of Uttar Pradesh : Agra, Allahabad, Lucknow, Varanasi, Kanpur, Gorakhpur, Jhansi, Faizabad, Bareilly, Muradabad, Ghaziabad, Meerut, Gautam Budh Nagar and Dehradun. The cities mentioned above are indicative.

Q17. How the admit card shall be generated?

Ans. The admit card can be downloaded from the Parishad's website [www.upavp.com](http://www.upavp.com) through the login ID and the password generated during registration process.

Q18. How the result of the examination can be viewed?

Ans. The result of the examination can be viewed on the Parishad's website [www.upavp.com](http://www.upavp.com)

Q19. Shall the travelling allowance(TA) be provided for going to the examination center?

Ans. No travelling allowance (TA) shall be provided for going to the examination center.

Q20. What is the last date of submission of hard copy of the documents?

Ans. There is no need to send hard Copies of the documents .

Q21. How to submit registration fee by e-challan and what are the bank details?

Ans. Candidate will select the offline mode and take the print out of E-Challan generated during registration process. The candidate would be able to submit the required fees in the bank after the challan is generated. Thereafter he/she will take Challan's hardcopy to any branch of HDFC Bank in U.P., submit the money and wherein he/she'll be issued a transaction ID. He/she'll again login on the website and resume the Registration process entering the transaction id/journal number issued from Bank.

Q22. Where to contact in case of doubt /inquiry ?

Ans. Candidates may contact to call center nos **1800-266-3556** and **E-mail ID-uphdb.lko@gmail.com** in case of doubt/ inquiry. Candidates are advised not to contact any body or person else in the department for any kind of doubt/inquiry.

Q23. Whether payment of fee by draft or cheque is allowed or permissible?

Ans. No, fee by draft or cheque is not permissible. Fee can be submitted offline in cash in any branch of HDFC Bank after generating bank challan or by online mode using debit/credit card.

Q24. Can I send form by post in physical form?

Ans. Candidates are not required to send the form in hard copy to the department.

Q25. Are original or photocopy of the documents required to be submitted with application form?

Ans. Candidates are not required to send the form in hard copy to the department.

Q26. Can I change my test city after payment is made online or offline?

Ans. No, candidates are not allowed to change their test city centre after payment is made online or offline.

Q27. I am resident of other state belonging to SC/ST OBC category. Can I get reservation benefit in above appointments?

Ans. No, candidates belonging to other state, can not get reservation benefit in above appointments. Only SC/ST/OBC candidates belonging to UP state shall have reservation benefit.
